Step 6—Go for a grading if you want

The instructors at the club will tell you when you are ready to go for a grading. This is usually done after an individual has spent a period of time training on basic technique and specific KATA appropriate to a belt level.

As with all Martial Art styles, intellectual property for developing the style and techniques belongs to the Head of Style. Our Head of Style is Sensei Takemori who lives in Japan. In recompense for developing the style, Sensei receives a portion of any grading fee charged.

Grading fees cover the cost of this intellectual property as well as dojo grading fees and the purchase of the relative belt that is achieved.

The following Grading fees apply from January 2011

Children up to 15years/ Full time students/ Pensioners

\$30.00—7th kyu to 1st kyu

\$50.00—sho dan and \$50.00 per dan thereafter e.g. 2nd = \$100

Adults

\$45.00—7th kyu to 4th kyu (blue belt)

\$55.00—3rd kyu (purple belt) to 1st kyu

\$100.00—sho dan and \$100.00 per dan thereafter up to max of \$500.00
e.g. 2nd = \$200

How to be part of the Seikukan Karate Club Wavell Heights Brisbane Incorporated (SKK)

Step 1—Become a member.

Fill out the 2011 membership form attached to this booklet and return it to the club.

Payment of membership fees entitles you to become a full member of SKK for 1 year. The club uses these fees to cover the costs including; insurance, affiliation with Japan SKK Headquarters, affiliation with Queensland Karate Association (QKA), affiliation with Australian Karate Federation (AKF), maintenance of club premises, and any required administration.

Once you have become a member you are eligible to participate in all QKA and AKF tournaments and events. You also have access to the gym facilities on the second floor if you fill the club's requirements.

Seniors (18+) membership fees	\$170
Juniors/Full-time students	\$130

Membership fees are to be paid within 2 weeks of commencing training. For people that join during the year, a pro-rata payment will need to be made based on a the time of year e.g. join in June, pay 1/2 membership fee.

Step 2—Look at the schedule of training.

The “session times” form is attached to this booklet, please look the times and decide on your training schedule. If you are not sure, please ask any of the club committee members listed on the front of this booklet or e-mail LeoSKK@bigpond.com or phone the club on 0409 536 533.

Step 3—Choose your training sessions.

It is recommended that at least 2 sessions a week are attended in order to progress.

Step 4—Decide on your payment method

Training fees cover attendance at training and can be paid in a number of ways to suit each person's training schedule. There are a number of payment options available and these are listed below.

Other discounts are available for family members if the annual fee is not chosen. A 10% discount will be given on membership. That is, if two juniors from the same family become members the fee will be:
 $2 \times \$130 = \260 less 10% = \$235
